We are happy to bring it to your attention that we have successfully completed yet another eventful year, our 54th year of MESCO and 45th Year of MESCO Education Society in the service of marginalized and underprivileged people. The Annual General Meeting of MESCO and MESCO Education Society successfully conducted on 24th September, 2022 at Karimi Library, CST Mumbai. This gives us immense pleasure to share the news that MESCO has been felicitated by the Nair Hospital on their 102nd Foundation Day Celebration on 5th September, 2022, towards supporting generously to the needy patients for their surgeries and treatment process. The Last quarter was loaded with activities and achievements for us at MESCO and MESCO Education Society. We at MESCO not only provide financial aid to the underprivileged students but also we are doing multiple activities for the holistic development of underprivileged students. During the last quarter we successfully conducted sessions on Job Readiness & Interview Etiquettes and Cyber Security. Felicitation program was organized on 30th July 2022 to felicitate MESCO's EAS and HCES students. MESCO also felicitated achievers named Ms. Shaikh Misbah and Mr. Gunwant Tanaji Shelar who have successfully passed C.A. and MPSC Examinations respectively. On Wednesday, 14th September, 2022, Felicitation program was organized to felicitate D.El.Ed and SSC students of RC Mahim Municipal School. We are glad to share that during last quarter 10 students who completed their graduation got placed in reputed MNC's. During the last quarter, we could able to service 2953 patients at our charitable clinic and 491 patients at our charitable physiotherapy center, Kausa. We have also started additional evening shift from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. at our Medical-Aid Dispensary from 22nd August, 2022. During last quarter MESCO successfully provided financial aid to 38 patients under life-saving chemotherapy and high-cost major surgeries, monthly medicines provided to 65 patients, 14 patients were assisted for minor surgeries and diagnostic tests, 35 dialysis patients have been supported under a six-month dialysis scheme, and 8 patients under sustained dialysis support scheme.

We would like to thank our donors, well-wishers, and ex-students for their help and support and appeal all of you to keep continue your support to MESCO for its causes, we will all together bring change in the society.

SUCCESS STORY

Today we would like to share with you a success story of Nasira, whose path to success wasn't easy and straight forward. She has overcome great obstacles on her rise to success.

Start with Nasira's father was Electrician with a meager income of Rs. 12,000/- per month and mother was a home maker with five students in the family and because of financial issues they all were studying in local Urdu medium school. Nasira was an ambitious and meritorious girl, who wanted to get into aeronautics since her childhood but her father wanted to see her as doctor, despite the fact that whole his family was against his decision and use to make fun of him and always tried to manipulate him for not giving higher education to his girls by saying "ladki ko zayada padhana nahi chahiye" 10 padhake shadi kardo " but Nasira was destined to become a doctor and her academic excellence earned her a scholarship from MESCO under Education Adoption Scheme (A Scholarship Program) when she was in std IX in the year 2013, through financial and moral support from MESCO, she completed her X with 85.80%, after X she was preparing for MHT CET and then suddenly it was announced that NEET marks will be considered for admission in Medical, hardworking Nasira prepared in 2 months for NEET. Luckily got selected in special counseling round through Maharashtra government MUHS University and got seat in Kolhapur for BHMS. It was a challenge for her father to overcome the taunts of family members for sending Nasira out of Mumbai. Against all odds Nasira stayed in a hostel and completed her course, she worked hard and moved her way up over the years, secured always ranking position all over Maharashtra in MUHS University and finally completed her final year of BHMS with distinction. Presently, she is a certified homoeopath working in a leading City Multispecialty hospital.

❖ As a proud moment, MESCO has been felicitated by the Nair Hospital on their 102nd Foundation Day Celebration on Monday, 5th September, 2022, for supporting generously to the needy patients for their surgeries and treatment process.



❖ 6 months Dialysis scheme - Forms Distribution program was held on Saturday, 10th September, 2022 at Anjuman-I-Islam Girls Primary School, Mahim. Total of 71 dialysis patients turned up for the dialysis assistance. The patients were selected by drawing random lots, these lots are picked by the patients in the presence of all the beneficiaries. Total of 54 patients has been selected through lottery process, they will be supported by MESCO for their 06 months dialysis expenses.

❖ During July to Sept 2022 quarter MESCO provided financial aid to the 38 beneficiaries under Life Saving Medical Aid Scheme for the major surgeries, chemotherapy and high cost medicines treatment taking place in government hospitals. Monthly medicines were provided to the 65 patients suffering from chronic ailments and 14 patients were assisted for the minor surgeries and diagnostic test under Medical Aid Scheme, 35 dialysis patients has been supported under Six months Dialysis scheme and 08 beneficiaries under Sustained dialysis support scheme.

One such case is of a 9 years Miss Malik Noor Sabah suffering from transfusion dependent Thalassemia diagnosed since the age of 02 years. Her monthly transfusion costs is Rs.1500/- with additional cost of medications required. As a sole bread earner, father doing zari work and earning Rs. 8000/- per month for survival of 5 family members. The child needs HLA testing in view of Bone marrow transplant. The cost for this procedure was highly unaffordable and unsound for the family's financial condition. MESCO was fortunately able to provide financial aid to the child for the procedure to enable her to live a qualitative and deserving life. Patient's parents are grateful to the Donors of MESCO for providing the timely help. MESCO takes pleasure and pride in bringing hopes in lives of such genuinely needy population and we strive to make it our sole motive every time.

The First cycle of Sewing Machine distribution was held on Thursday, 7th July, 2022, Total 12 Sewing Machines distributed. The Second cycle of Sewing Machine distribution was held on Saturday, 1st October, 2022, Total 44 Sewing Machines distributed. We have Ration Support Distribution Scheme in which we distributed dry ration in 10 areas to around 432 families. We are also distributing ration to the 34 elderly people of Kaynaat Old Age Home, Uttan.

SUCCESS STORY

1) Ms. Babita Sunil Paswan, Applicant's husband work as carpenter and manages to earn Rs. 10,000/- per month, applicant is a house wife. The family lives in a rented house for which they pay Rs. 4,000/- monthly. There are 3 students in the family, the elder one is in graduation and other two are in school (IX/VI), both are studying in local Municipal School. The family's major part of income goes in rent, which makes it difficult for them to manage



other expenses. Hence, MESCO inducted the family in Ration Support Scheme.

2) Madhuri Vijay Sharma, Applicant's husband expired due to cancer in 2015, She has 2 daughters both are doing graduation in Biotechnology and also working parttime to support their mother and manage their college fees. Applicant does imitation jewellery work and manage to earn Rs. 7,000/- per month. After Lockdown it was extremely difficult for them to manage their daily expenses. Applicant will continue under Ration Support Scheme of MESCO till her daughters complete their graduation and able to support their family.
